SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS

General information

For the occasion of the 3rd GA²FA, we are offering you the opportunity to participate in the abstract sessions as part of a planned range of educational activities.

This is a great opportunity for you to share your knowledge, have their poster presented in front of key opinion leaders in the field and be acknowledged as active contributors in the GA²FA 2025 Forum.

All participants with interesting abstracts are encouraged to submit for consideration.

All the abstracts presenters will benefit from the early registration fee at the term of their abstract acceptance

Submission rules:

Participants may submit up only a case disease area, including:

1- Anaphylaxis* a- mechanisms, b- epidemiology, c- treatment

**NB: Abstracts on anaphylaxis may be invited to present an oral abstract at the Anaphylaxis Research Symposium on Thursday Sept 11th at 08.30-12.30 IN BOLD*

2- Drug Allergy

3- Food allergy a- epidemiology, b diagnosis, c- treatment

4- Venom allergy a- diagnosis, b-treatment

5- Living with food allergies (travel, school etc.)

6- Miscellaneous

The abstract should be submitted only once: resubmission is not permitted.

The abstract for your poster must have a short, specific title (containing no abbreviations). The main text should be limited to 1,950 characters (about 300-350 words). This includes the text plus any graphics, but not the title or authors.

The use of trademarks is prohibited, only International Non-proprietary Names (INN), e.g. generic drug names, are allowed.

Indicate minimum 2, maximum 3 keywords which best correspond to the content of your research topic. All abstracts and posters must be submitted in English with accurate grammar and spelling suitable for publication.

As it is in the intent of Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network to provide high-quality sessions focused on educational content that is free from commercial influence or bias, all potential conflicts of interest need to be declared.

Poster format

All posters will be submitted in a PDF format.

It is advisable to structure the poster in the following sections, following the logical order of evolution:

- Title of the poster (abbreviated to coincide with the name of the file and author). Title should refer to the topic, directly or indirectly.

Authors

The first author (=presenting author) is responsible for the content and is the contact person for communication purposes and dissemination of information to co-authors.

The first author (=presenting author) should be a person, who personally participated in the described clinical case.

- First author and co-authors need to provide their: full name and affiliation.
- The first author may nominate a co-author to present a clinical case in his/her place, provided that a co-author was a member of the team who was directly involved in the case.
- Ensure that all authors complete the “Conflict of Interest” statement identifying any financial interest in products or processes involved in their activities.

Submission date

Abstract submission by email to: gafa.scientific@ga2len.network will remain open **until 20th July 2025**, and abstracts can be edited until this time.

Selection of Posters

Submitted abstracts will be sent for peer review by a panel of three experts in the field of anaphylaxis and food allergy (Scientific Programme Committee), and scored to determine which are accepted/rejected.

Notification of acceptance/non-acceptance status will be communicated **29th July 2025**. Please ensure that the email provided for the presenting author is accurate as all correspondences will be sent via email, to the presenting author.

Once presented, the Scientific Programme Committee and attendees of the meeting will vote the best poster based on the following criteria:

- Originality
- Novelty
- Clarity of conclusions according to methodology and results
- Duration of the presentation (in compliance with the submission rules)
- Quality of the oral presentation performance

Awards

There will be 6 prizes of a 300 Euro:

- 3 for the best poster voted by the Scientific Programme Committee and
- 3 for the best poster voted by the audience.

Data protection

Participants authorize Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network to capture the personal data (name, surname, position or job, image, and voice) during the participation in the clinical cases session.

Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network will carry out interviews, photographic reports/audio-visual/sound recordings on its own behalf or through a third party, through capturing images, sound, contributions, interpretations and/or recording by means of video or photography.

Therefore, participants grant Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network an irrevocably non-exclusive right to process and use its own image and personal data, in accordance with the provisions of Law 1/1982, of May 5, the Protection of the Right to Honour, Personal and Family Privacy and Own Image.

For this purpose, the participant gives its consent to the process and use its own image and personal data in accordance with the following clauses:

- a) The participant transfers to Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network the exploitation rights of the recorded images, for the maximum time allowed by law and for all countries in the world.
- b) The participant gives its consent, without limitation, to the following uses of its own image and name recorded by Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network using the technical means currently used and those that may be developed in the future:
 - i) Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network will use the recordings to publicize Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network internal activities. The recorded images will be used for promotional activities by Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network, in any of the possible formats, including exposure and promotion through the internet and on the different websites of Global Allergy and Asthma Excellence Network.
